Starting May 8th, LFCS will begin a trial program for extended care that will run BEFORE school from 6am - 8am. This program is for K-5 grades at the LA and for 4th - 6th grade at the JA.

This opportunity will be an early morning educational program that will include educational activities, playtime and breakfast.

LFCS is contracting with an outside agency that will be providing this service for us. We have confidence that this group understands LFCS and our values.
